Choreographed by Emma Parker, *Exteroeception* explores a blind dancer's experience of the world before and after losing sight. Parker, an Indiana-based movement leader for special-needs students, is passionate about integrated dance. "I want to be part of the movement to mainstream performance and bring it to a wider audience," she says. She hopes to dance with mixed-ability dance companies and pursue a master's degree in movement therapy. Lonnie Bedwell, who inspired and performs in the piece, was blinded in a hunting accident.
