【Vision of NTUS Olympic Education】

In the future, we hope that NTUS can establish Taiwan's first Olympic themed museum and build up a Taiwanese Sport Hall of Fame, including Eastern-Western sports culture relics. The exhibition hall can consist of Asian and non-Asian sports events, the relics of Taiwanese aboriginals, and the media of Olympic Games. Other than that, our university has established Olympic related courses and the first Olympic Studies Society to help young talented students to take part related educational events organized by Chinese Taipei Olympic Committee, including students exchange scheme.

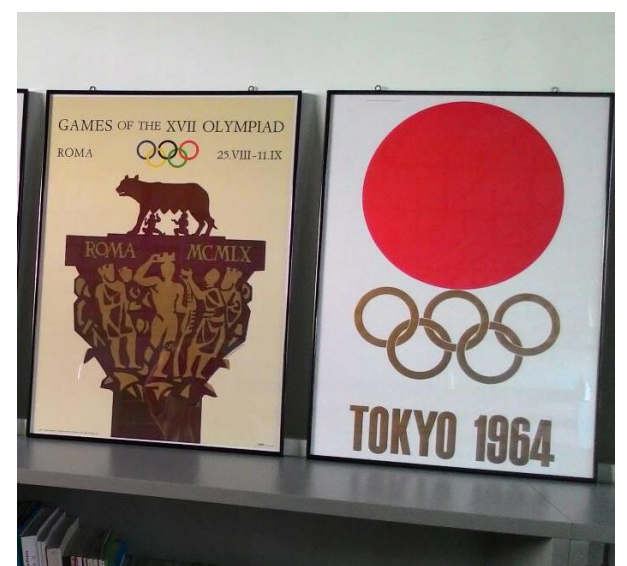

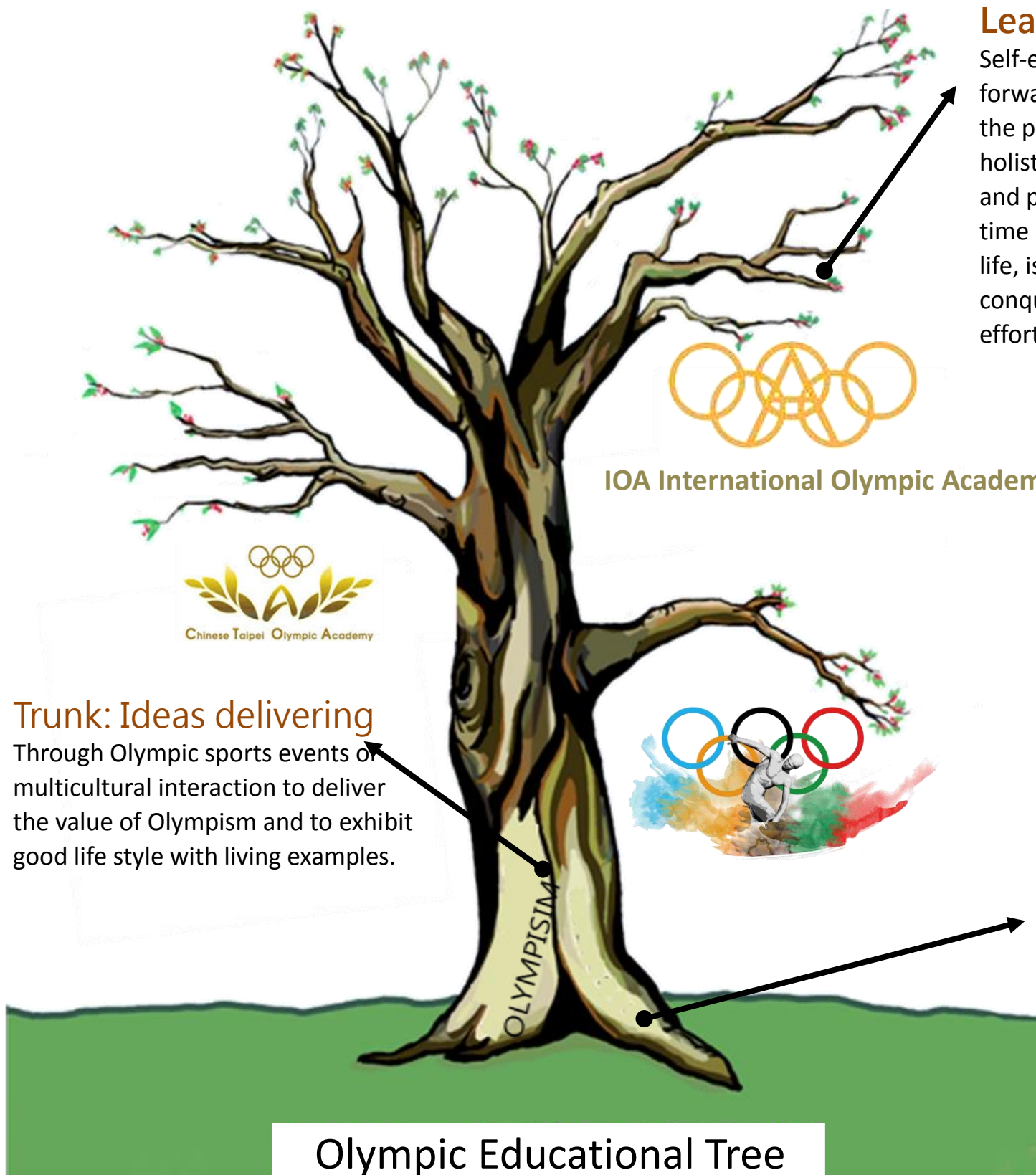
Leaf & Fruit: Glory and Reward.
